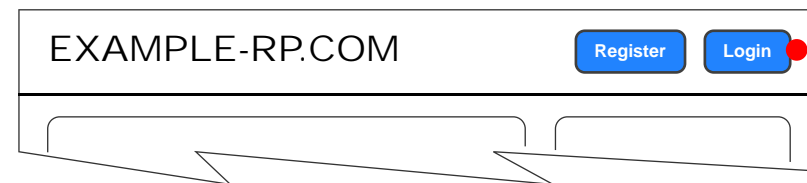

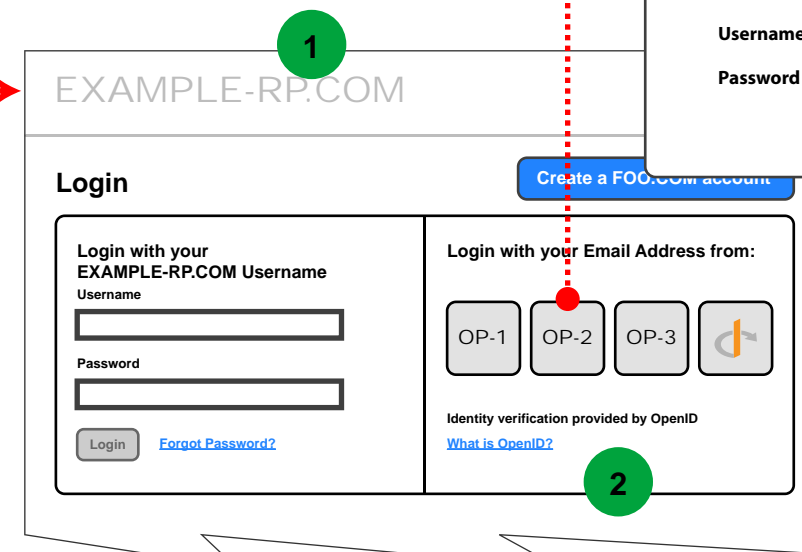

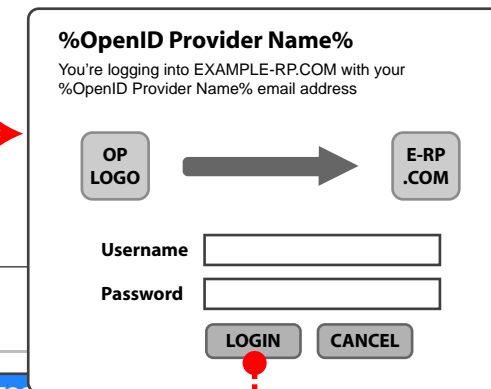
## 1.1 Standard Register/Login call to action in navigation



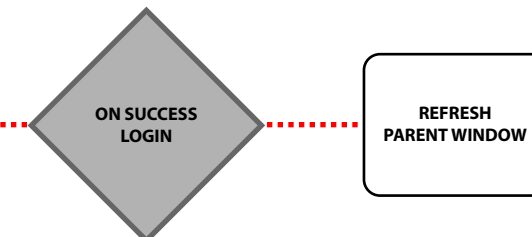
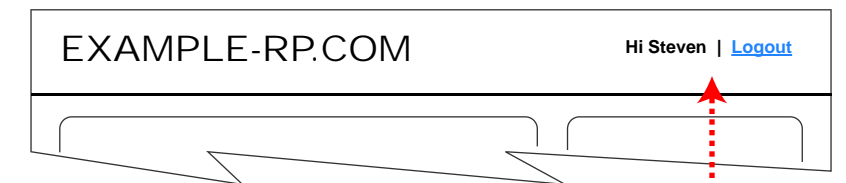
## 1.2 Login form with OP button array

## OpenID Provider Action Buttons

- Check Immediate not required from OpenID Provider
- Presumes the user knows if they are registered on RP website
- **No clear benefit to user if they already have an account at RP website**
- May be more effective in the registration process. For example, quick registration without email verification



## Activate Tunnel navigation

Removing any links not related to logging and returning to home



Relying Party should determine which OpenId Providers best meets their media vertical or web application

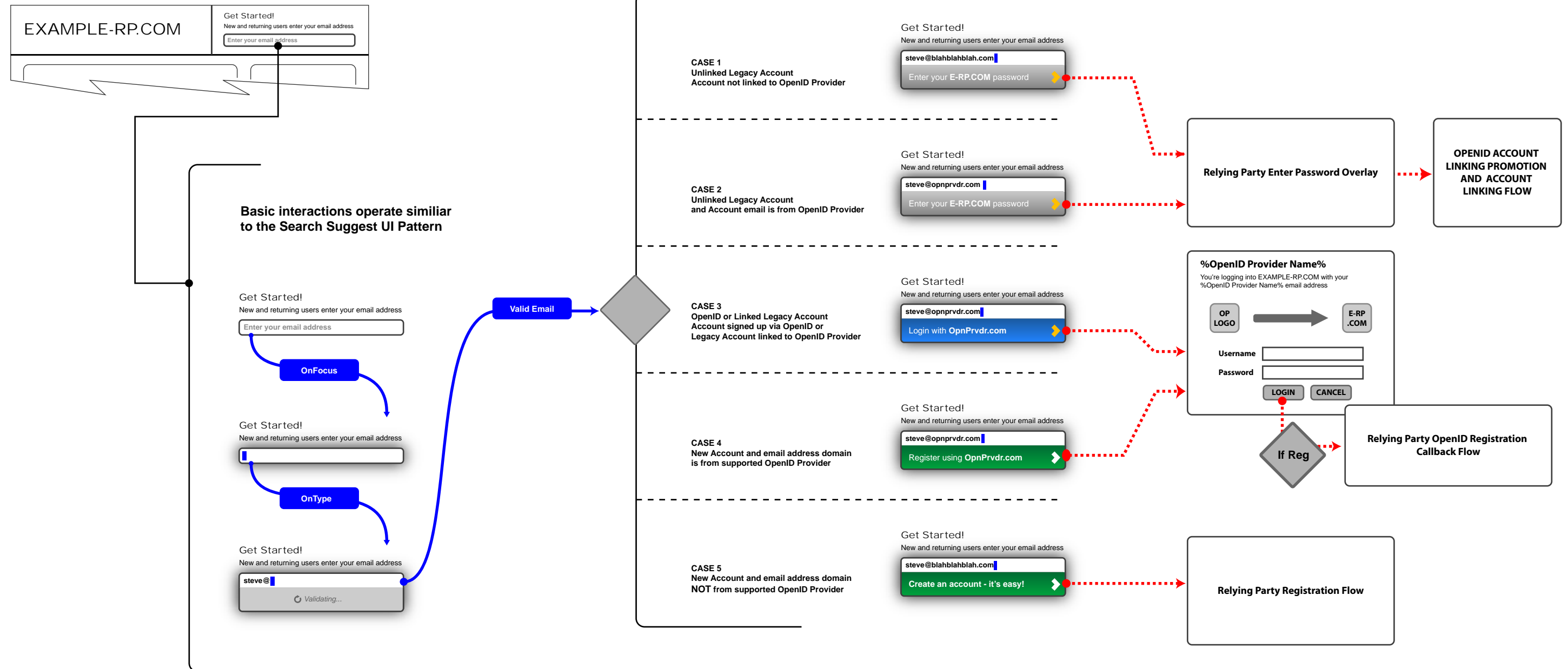

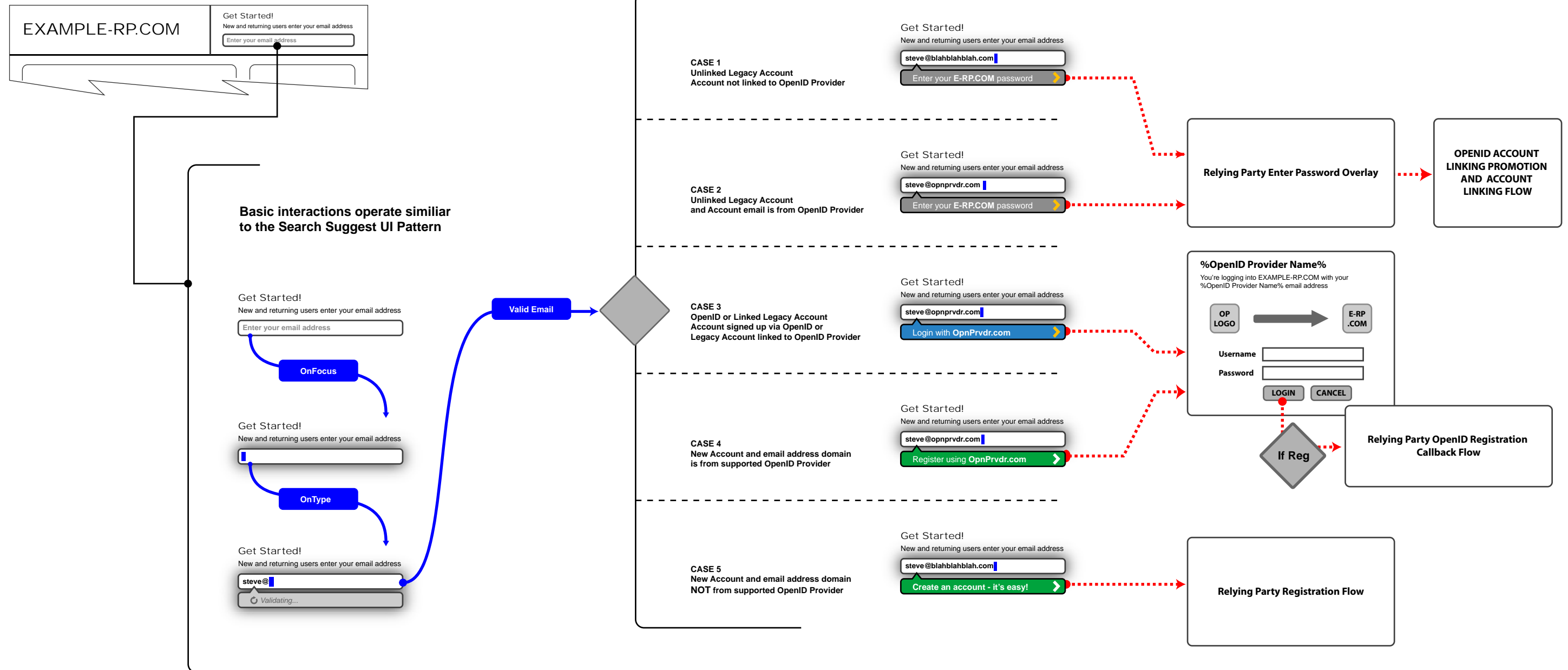

In this layout a slight modification is made to the **Action Button layout** by adding a OpenID provider lookup textbox below the array of promoted OpenID providers.
